**Terms of Use**

**These terms will be read to and explained with each class**

- 1) The school network is available for the learning to use the computer and for research work related to school. I will not use it for private internet e-mail or non – school related activities.
- 2) I will not bully another person using email or internet facilities
- 3) I will not swear, use vulgar or inappropriate language on the school computer network.
- 4) I will not share anybody's home address, phone numbers on the network. I will not share my password with other pupils of the school. I understand that e-mail is not private and may be read by the principal or other staff. I understand that I am not allowed to use the "everyone" or other *group* email addresses, unless specifically asked by a teacher to do so.
- 5) I will not use the network in a way that is disruptive to others.
- 6) I will not intentionally seek information, obtain copies or change information belonging to other users of the network.
- 7) I understand that if I *try* to gain unauthorized access to system programmes or computer equipment the privileges of computer use will be withdrawn, and my parents contacted. If I become a security risk or have a series of problems with the network I will be denied access to the school computers for a specified period.
- 8) I will not download onto any disc or personal network without specific teacher approval.
- 9) I understand that any vandalism of school computing equipment will involve the cancellation of privileges to be followed by the usual consequences for breaking school rules.
- 10) I understand that the ICT Director has access to all pupil files and is able to check my computer usage.

**MBIS. Net - Terms and Conditions.**

**(Jan 2006 edition)**

1) The school network is available for the learning to use the computer and for research work related to school. It is not for private internet e-mail or non-school related activities.

**Students are:**

2) not to swear, use vulgar or any other in appropriate language. Illegal activities are strictly forbidden. Not to **bully** another person using online facilities.

3) a) not to reveal their own or **any other** person's home address, phone number over the network.

b) not to reveal or tell their own or **any other** person's password to any other person.

4) not to use the network in such a way that it would disrupt its use by others

5) to regard all communications and information accessible via the network to be private property (i.e. copyrighted) and therefore must be acknowledged in any subsequent work produced by the pupil

6) to be aware that MBIS reserves the right to make determinations about the use of the network and the ICT Director has access to all student documents stored on the MBIS network.

7) not to intentionally seek information belonging to others or misrepresent other users of the network.

8) be aware that attempts to gain unauthorized access to the system programmes or computer equipment will result in the cancellation of user privileges.

9) to understand that the downloading of information onto a users personal network file is permissible, but not downloading onto floppy disks without specific teacher permission. No discs may be installed onto any computer on the network without the written permission of the ICT teacher.

10) to understand that any user identified as a security risk, or who has a history of problems with other computer systems may be denied access to school computers.

11) to understand that vandalism will result in the cancellation of privileges, as well as other sanctions/costs cited in the school rules. **Vandalism is defined (for purposes of this document) as any malicious attempt to harm, modify or destroy computer hardware and /or the data of another network user.**

This includes loss of data from delays, non-deliveries, mis-deliveries or service interruptions caused by its own negligence or users errors or omissions.
