To the Murrays Bay, and Extended Community

The Board of Trustees of Murrays Bay Intermediate, based on an extraordinary number of enrolments during Enrolment Week this year, and pending local projections, has made the decision to enforce the Murrays Bay Intermediate School zone. This decision considers our need to provide a quality learning experience for all students and not compromise facilities, resources and school structure.

We will be enforcing the allocated school zone from Friday 8th September.

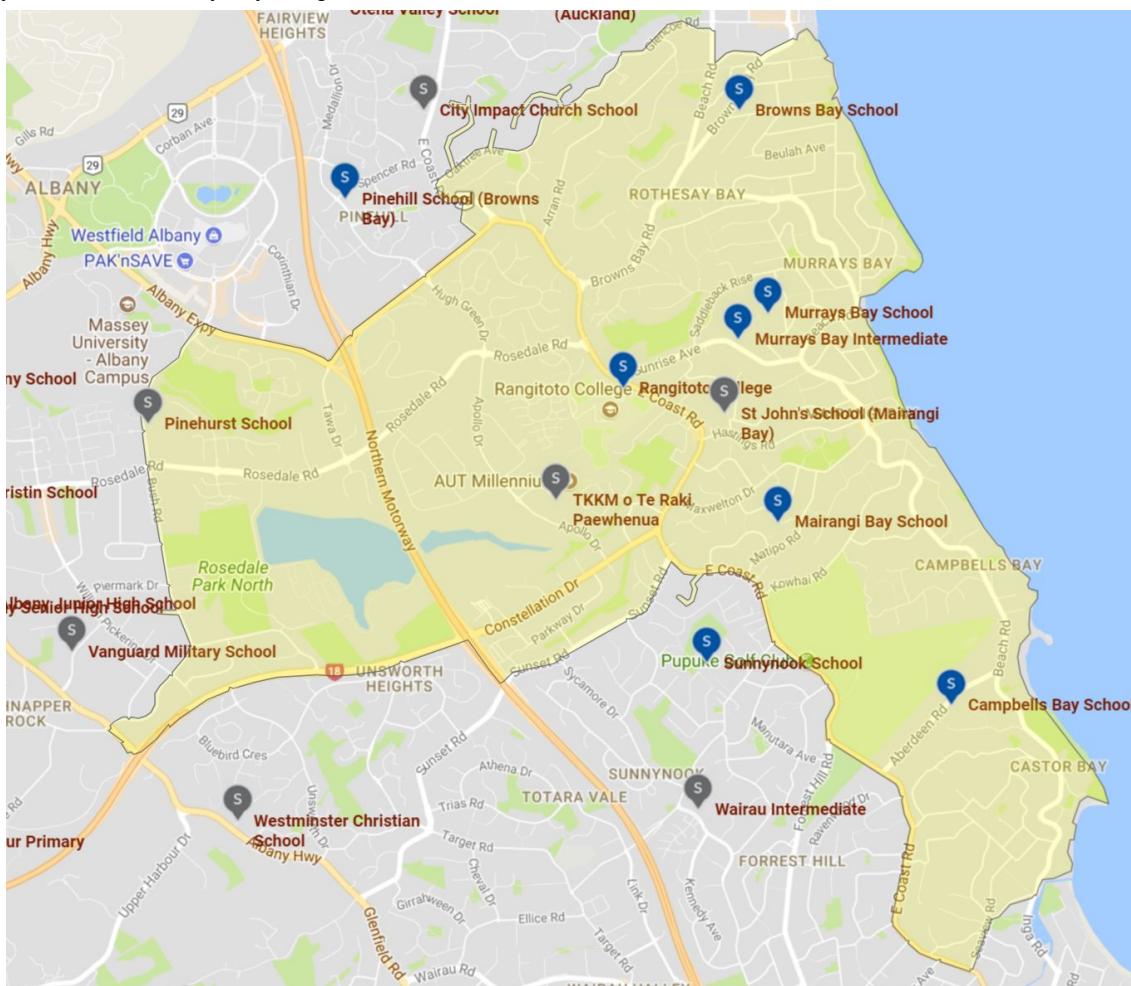
All students who enrolled during Enrolment Week will be able to attend next year, both in and out of zone. All families who have pre-enrolled (applied online but haven't had an interview) by the 8th of September will be contacted, and if out of zone **MUST enrol immediately. Families who are out of zone and have already booked an enrolment interview with the school, will have a place in 2018.**

We will accept all students who live within our school zone. At the enrolment interview, from Monday 11th September, families must be able to provide proof that their family is living in our In Zone Home area. Families are unable to move temporarily into the In Zone Home area and move out once their child has started at Murrays Bay Intermediate. Under these circumstances an enrolment can be annulled.

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year from now on, the Board of Trustees will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The Board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority as per MOE specifications:

- First Priority** This priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.
- Second Priority** will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.
- Third Priority** will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.
- Fourth Priority** will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.

Fifth Priority will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.

Sixth Priority will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the Secretary. Under Section 11G (1) on the Education Act 1989.

For this year, a ballot will be conducted on Friday 1st December for families who are living outside of our school zone if places are available. You can contact jenny.pan@mbi.school.nz to register your interest. However, there should be no expectation that out of zone places will be available given the pressure on the school roll as described in paragraph one of this letter.

If you have enrolled, and do not require a place at Murrays Bay Intermediate School next year, please let jenny.pan@mbi.school.nz know as soon as possible.

The guidelines for development and operation of Enrolment schemes are issued under section 11G(3) of the Education Act 1989 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers about Enrolment schemes will be exercised.
